Yamadera Temple

Yamadera is a scenic temple located in the mountains northeast of Yamagata City. The temple grounds extend high up a steep mountainside, from where there are great views down onto the valley. The temple was founded over a thousand years ago in 860 as a temple of the Tendai sect under the official name Risshakuji. Its popular name, Yamadera, literally means "mountain temple" in Japanese.

Ginzan Onsen

The town is home to wooden hot spring inns lining each side of the Ginzan River and resonates with nostalgic beauty when illuminated at night by gas street lamps. The night view of the town blanketed in snow beneath the warm streetlights is particularly photogenic during winter.


Yudonosan

Shiroishi Castle

Shiroishi Castle (also known as Masuoka Castle) is a flatland-mountain castle(a castle built on a hill and plateau so that there were be a elevation advantage in battle) located at the heart of the city of Shiroishi (Masuoka Park). A key point south of the Sendai fiefdom, it was the resident castle of the Katakura clan, a chief vassal of the Date family, for around 260 years until the Meiji Restoration, after the Battle of Sekigahara.

Zao Fox Village

Zao Fox Village is Japan's largest fox-themed zoo, located in an hour drive from Sendai. More than 100 foxes live free-range in a garden surrounded by nature, and you can watch foxes without a fence in between. Visitors can enjoy attractive programs such as feeding the foxes and photo shoot with the foxes. In addition, there are other animals such as rabbits and goats that you can also interact with. In recent years, as word-ofmouth spread, more and more international tourists have come to visit this unique attraction.

Zao Kokeshi Museum

Located a stone's throw from Togatta Onsen, the Zao Kokeshi Museum boasts boasts a collection of kokeshi dolls 5,500 strong—the largest in Japan! Kokeshi are a traditional craft that originated in the hot springs regions of northern Japan. Characteristics such as the shapes and facial features of the dolls are unique to each region. At the Zao Kokeshi Museum, you can wander through displays of kokeshi from all over the Tohoku region.

Koiwai Farm

With a history stretching back over 120 years, Koiwai Farm is an important local landmark with part of its vast 3,000-hectare grounds, known as "Makiba-en", open to the public. Visitors can enjoy the gorgeous natural surroundings, learn about the production of a range of dairy products and visit some of the 21 buildings on the farm designated Important Cultural Properties.

Esashi-Fujiwara Heritage Park

Across 20 hectares, the Esashi Fujiwara Heritage Park is lined with around 120 Heianstyle buildings of different sizes, including the Kyaranogosho, a recreation of the shindenzukuri buildings that were the residences of Heian aristocrats; the Tsunekiyo Hall and Kiyohira Hall, reproductions of samurai halls; and the Seicho, the government office that governed political affairs.

Jodogahama Beach

Jodogahama Beach in the Sanriku Geopark is located within the Sanriku Fukko National Park and is officially recognised as a place of scenic beauty. The beach sits on a peaceful inlet formed by volcanic white rocks and pebbles and contrasts beautifully with the surrounding green pine grove, reminding visitors of the beauty of traditional Japanese rock gardens. Legend has it that a Buddhist priest who once visited compared the beach's beauty to Buddha's Paradise giving rise to the name Jodogahama (Buddha's Paradise Beach).

Yahiko-jinja Shrine

Widely revered as the leading shrine of the Echigo region (the former name of Niigata), Yahiko Shrine, or Oyahiko-sama, draws over 200,000 worshippers for "hatsumode" (New Year's visit) each year. Its roots trace back more than 2,400 years, as documented in the Manyoshu, Japan's oldest poetry anthology. The shrine is believed to bring blessings in marriage, and is dedicated to Amenokagoyama no Mikoto, the great-grandchild of goddess Amaterasu.

Teradomari Street Market

The Teradomari Street Market is located near Teradomari Port in Nagaoka City, along Route 402 facing the Sea of Japan. The market is lined with seafood stalls, including 11 fishmongers and souvenir stores, promising a treasure trove of fresh and affordable high-quality food. This includes not only seafood from the local Teradomari and Izumozaki ports but also frozen seafood and packaged delicacies to bring home.

Nagaoka Fireworks Museum

Nagaoka Fireworks Museum is a completely new type of next-generation roadside station that provides a diverse array of services to its users. It functions as a place of rest and recuperation for users, a place that shows the wonder of Nagaoka and as a hub of information on the local area.
